OPPORTUNITIES TO HELP IN YOUR COMMUNITY

**Volunteer:**

**PARENT AIDE:**

**Volunteer Parent Aides:** The Parent Aide program is designed to reach into the communities through volunteer “lay therapists” or what is now known as “Parent Aides.” The agency offers a 13 hour training on child abuse and neglect and working with at-risk families to those interested parties willing to lend a hand to make a difference to stop the cycle of abuse. These volunteers work with a family at-risk for abuse and neglect through 1-2 hours a week contact. Outside of training for working with the families the volunteer is also offered on-going support and supervision both individual and group based as well as an agency that is available 24-hrs for needed assistance in working with the families.

**ADOLESCENT PARENTING PROGRAM:**

**Mentors:** The APP program also offers opportunities for volunteers to become mentors for the adolescent mothers and fathers in the program. The mentors receive a 13 hour training to prepare them to work with the adolescents to achieve their program goals. The main purpose of the mentors is to provide the adolescents the needed support to stay in school and avoid a repeat pregnancy. Mentors are provided the same on-going support and supervision as Parent Aides.

**Donations:** Baby items: diapers, wipes, baby/toddler clothing, formula, baby/toddler toys, books, strollers, new car seats, maternity clothing, playpens, swings, cribs, etc.

**PARENTING CLASSES:**

Childcare volunteers are needed for the Tuesday (5:30-7pm) and Thursday (6-8pm) night parenting classes.

**Donations & Supplies:**

The agency is in continual need of monetary donations to expand services and pay for needed office supplies. In addition, office supplies and program supplies (such as baby/toddler items, school supplies, household cleaning supplies, furniture, and gently used clothing/shoes) are always in need. Christmas gifts are solicited during the Holiday season for needy families.
