

“Battle of the Bowls”

6th Annual Chicken Stew Cook-Off Oct 15, 2016

To benefit SCAN-Stop Child Abuse Now

Our Purpose is to have many kinds of Chicken Stew available to the ticket holders for tasting or buying full bowls through donations. An entry ticket is \$5.00 for 6 taste tickets.

If they would like to purchase more tickets for more tastes or a bowl, then it is \$1.00 per taste ticket.

We will have **Judges Choice**, which will judge two categories at 3:30 PM:

Old Fashioned Traditional and Freestyle.

All entrants will have 5 taste cups prepared for the judges. The actual event starts at 4:00. The general public will vote for the **People’s Choice Award** by filling your voting jars with tickets. **It will be helpful for you to win this category by inviting all your friends, family and co-worker to come down and vote for your stew.** This is where the majority of the donations will come from so it is extremely important to have your “fan club” participate. The third award will be the **Most Creative Award** voted on by the Exchange Club and volunteers.

Entrant Instructions:

- 1. \$25 non-refundable fee is required to reserve your space.**
2. The stew can be any tried and tested concoction that contains Chicken. You must be willing to submit a recipe. It can be cream based, tomato based, etc. All expenses will be incurred for the ingredients by the entrants.
3. The stew should preferably be cooked off location. We want to keep it as sanitary as possible. A minimum of 7 gallons of stew is required. Exchange Club will provide 6 pint-sized containers to each contestant for the final sell off. Contestants should bring extra containers as well.
4. The stew can be kept warm in a gas powered, covered Turkey Fryer and/or a covered slow cooker. It has been recommended that both be available but is not necessary.
4. There will be 1 electrical outlet for each entrant. If you need more, bring your own surge protector. You will need an extension cord as well.

5. All entrants will be required to provide their own tent cover and table(s). You may decorate / stage your area anyway you'd like. Each entrant will be allotted an equal sized space.

6. The entrants will need teams of 2 or 3 and will need to have aprons worn at all times to signify you are an entrant. Let us know if you need an apron supplied to you.

7. All taste cups and soup bowls will be provided to the entrants so we will have uniformity. One ticket for a taste, 3 tickets for a bowl. Everyone must have a ticket to receive ANY stew from the entrants.

8. At the end of the event, the Exchange Club will elect "counters" and the one with the most tickets will be the winner of the **People's Choice Award**. The awards will be presented by 6:45 the day of the event. All winners will be announced in the Kernersville News and the Chamber of Commerce newsletter.

9. The Exchange Club and Chick Fil A will provide two Water Stations for the entrants. One for washing/ cleaning hands and one for cleaning utensils. There will be bathrooms available in Town Hall at the courtroom entrance.

10. We request all entrants carry everything off site that they brought on. We will have volunteers collecting trash but we request the food does not go into any drainage system.

11. All NEW Entrants will be available Sunday, Oct. 7, at 4:00 PM at the Kernersville Farmers Market for a meeting to go over the rules, the location, the time element, and any changes that we have made.

These rules are preliminary and are subject to change.
